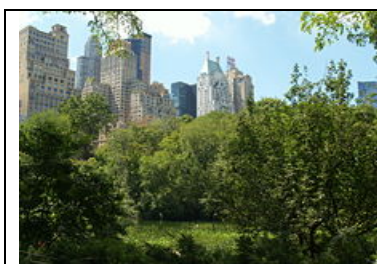


## The Midtown Madness Tour

### List of sights you will see on this tour

Your tour may be customized to spend more or less time at particular sights of interest to you, as well as ones you'd rather skip. On all our private tours, **sights are seen from both inside *and* outside the vehicle.**



**Central Park:** Begin your tour with a 30-minute walk through the world's most famous park. Your guide takes you up to the top of a bluff for amazing views of the park & the City. Meander on through "The Mall", shown in countless movies to Bethesda Fountain, the centerpiece of Central Park.



**The Plaza Hotel / 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue:** After your walk through Central Park you'll be standing right in front of the most famous & most filmed hotel in the world. A slow drive down 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue shows you the famous shopping Mecca.



**Rockefeller Center:** Explore on foot with your guide St. Patrick's Cathedral and the buildings and sculptures that make up this celebrated urban complex, home to NBC Studios, the famous Christmas Tree, ice-skating rink and popular television show 30 Rock.



**Top of the Rock observation deck:** From the rooftop of the 30 Rockefeller Plaza skyscraper you'll take in sweeping views of the entire city which is spread out before you. Your guide will provide you with a detailed overview of New York City from this awesome and unique perspective.



**Times Square / Broadway:** Stand front and center in the middle of the Crossroads of the World for some amazing views and photo opps. Hear your guide share the history, stories and many interesting facts about this fabled district.



**East 42<sup>nd</sup> Street:** Take a short walking tour of some of the best examples of Art Deco-style skyscrapers in New York City: the Chrysler Building, Chanin Building and Daily News buildings.



**Grand Central Terminal:** Your walk through the beautiful Beaux-Arts building with a knowledgeable guide at your side is as good as it gets. Explore all the interesting nooks and crannies of this grand building and learn some things that will surely astonish you!



**The New York Public Library:** From your vehicle you'll see the beautiful building that is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest library in the country. Ever see the movie Day After Tomorrow? Look familiar?



**Empire State Building:** You'll step out of your vehicle to view the most iconic building in the world. We guarantee you there are some interesting things you didn't know about this beloved building!



**Flatiron Building:** A quick stop to view this building from outside the vehicle is the only way you can truly appreciate its quirkiness. "Oh, wow!..." is a common response to first seeing this odd yet beautiful structure.
