### List of sights you will see on this tour

Your tour may be customized to spend more or less time at particular sights of interest to you, as well as ones you'd rather skip. On all our private tours, **sights are seen from both inside *and* outside the vehicle.**

	<p><b>Central Park:</b> Begin your tour with a 30-minute walk through the world's most famous park. Your guide takes you up to the top of a bluff for amazing views of the park &amp; the City. Meander on through "The Mall", shown in countless movies to Bethesda Fountain, the centerpiece of Central Park.</p>
	<p><b>Rockefeller Center:</b> Explore on foot with your guide St. Patrick's Cathedral and the buildings and sculptures that make up this celebrated urban complex, home to NBC Studios, the famous Christmas Tree, ice-skating rink and popular television show 30 Rock.</p>
	<p><b>Top of the Rock observation deck:</b> From the rooftop of the 30 Rockefeller Plaza skyscraper you'll take in sweeping views of the entire city which is spread out before you. Your guide will provide you with a detailed overview of New York City from this awesome and unique perspective.</p>



**Greenwich Village:** Meander through the narrow, tree-lined streets with your guide and you'll instantly be caught under its spell. Far removed from the skyscrapers of Midtown, here you'll feel like your in a small town somewhere that's not New York, yet this is probably the most characteristically New York neighborhood of them all! The history of Greenwich Village that is. Cafes, artists, reformers & intellectuals. More has happened here to influence popular culture than perhaps any other neighborhood in the world. You'll LOVE this place. LOTS to discover here.

**City Hall / City Hall Park:** Home of "Mayor Mike" and the oldest City Hall in the country still in use. City Hall Park also has some amazing history. You'll be able to get out here and admire the beautiful buildings up close.



**St. Paul's Chapel:** You'll take a walk with your guide through this hallowed building that has stood as witness to some of the most historic events of this country.



**Ground Zero:** Here you'll get a chance to visit the firehouse directly across the street from Ground Zero and talk to one of the firefighters personally. Right across the street is Ground Zero. Take a peek through the fence to see the actual construction going on.



**Wall Street / Financial District:** Take a walk through the City's and our nation's financial capital. This is also the oldest part of the City, when it was originally called New Amsterdam. How did it all start? What made New York the capital of commerce? Learn all this and more.



**Staten Island Ferry / Statue of Liberty:** Take a ride on the Staten Island Ferry for inspiring, up-close views of the Statue of Liberty, Governor's Island and the New York Harbor. There's no doubt you'll learn some new facts and stories you've never heard before!



**Brooklyn Bridge:** Take one of the most dramatic walks in New York City, over the famous Brooklyn Bridge with your guide. Hear the stories of old New York as you ponder the breathtaking views of the New York waterfront and skyline.



**Brooklyn Heights / Brooklyn Promenade:** America's first suburb and the first historic district ever designated. Wander the narrow, tree-lined streets where you'll see the gorgeous 19<sup>th</sup> century architecture that makes this quaint and quiet and historic neighborhood so famous. Hear you'll learn about the some of the amazing history that helped shaped our country. Talk a walk on the promenade where a few famous movies were filmed for picture perfect views of Manhattan.



**D.U.M.B.O.:** A relatively new trendy neighborhood home to artists escaping the increasing high rents of Manhattan, this area is now becoming more desirable with its unique streetscape, cool boutiques, galleries, intimate performance spaces and some of the best views of Manhattan. A walk through along the waterfront in DUMBO promises to be one of your most memorable New York City moments.
