Thursday, April 9th

Hotel accommodations

- You pay one price and your hotel and everything else listed in your package is paid for in one simple transaction.
- A list of hotel choices will be provided for you to select from. You will have a good amount of flexibility when choosing your hotel. If you have a specific hotel you would like to use in your package, just let us know!
- The least expensive times of year to visit: January – February & July – August. More expensive hotels are available at large discounts during this time frame.
- When your package reservation is complete your hotel will be secured right away and a hotel confirmation number will be given to you.
- Your package includes room and tax only. Incidentals (phone, room service, etc.) are paid for separately by you.

Helicopter Tour

- Tours depart from the Downtown Manhattan Heliport, pier 6 and the East River.
- Tours are available throughout the day, Monday through Saturday. For Sunday tours, the Midtown Manhattan heliport is available for an additional \$15pp fee.
- Transportation to the heliport is not included but is certainly available to you upon request for an additional charge. Taxis are easily available and inexpensive.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- Tour description: 6 – 8 minutes in length. Experience the thrill of a helicopter flight while flying south down the Hudson River, viewing Downtown Manhattan, the Financial District, Ellis and Governors Island and the world famous Statue of Liberty. As you return north up the Hudson River you will view the skyline of Manhattan including the Empire State Building!

Broadway show

- Choose from over 30 shows, from famous Broadway musicals like Lion King, Jersey Boys and Wicked to dramas, comedies, Broadway revivals, and the latest productions to hit the stage.
- Your electronic tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is

less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.

- E-tickets give you the added value of security and peace of mind in case you lose your actual tickets. Since we will have additional copies of your tickets on file, we can just e-mail them to you or fax them to your hotel!
- You may choose which play you want to see. If the show you want is sold-out or only has lesser value seats available, you have the option of either paying a higher per-ticket price for this show (usually \$50 - \$100 more per ticket) or choose a different show. Premium seats to shows - which are the first 10 rows, center stage - are also available for an additional \$100 - \$150 per ticket depending on the show.
- If you have a preference, you may choose which day you would like to see your show. Most theaters are dark on Mondays. Evening performances are at either 7pm or 8pm while matinees are at either 2pm or 3pm (usually on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays).
- The theater does not have a dress code. The majority of people will be slightly dressed up while there will be people wearing jeans or shorts and t-shirts as well.
- All Broadway theaters are located in the Theater District (41st Street to 57th Street between 6th Avenue and 8th Avenue), within easy walking distance to most Midtown Manhattan hotels. Transportation to the theater is not required in most cases and is therefore not included in our packages. Car service can always be arranged upon request.

Off-Broadway

- Your tickets include the best available seats for the particular show you choose.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets.
- Off-Broadway theaters can be anywhere in Manhattan. Transportation to the theater is not included but is certainly available to you upon request for an additional charge. Taxis are easily available and inexpensive.
- The theater does not have a dress code. The majority of people will be slightly dressed up while there will be people wearing jeans or shorts and t-shirts as well.

Museums

- Locations: Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum, West 42nd Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue; Ripley's Odditorium, West 42nd Street between 7th Avenue and 8th Avenue (next to Madame Tussaud's).
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.

- Your admission to the Wax Museum includes entrance to the brand new Cinema 4D, the new ultra-sensory experience at Madame Tussauds New York that delivers amazing 3-D technology with 4-D effects including wind, mist and scent, Digital Surround Sound and an exciting lineup of films. Before getting on this unpredictable 4-D journey you will also get exclusive access to Madame Tussaud's Behind the Scenes interactive exhibit and be amazed at how their studio artists make the wax figures look so real.
- You may visit these museums/attractions anytime during their normal operating hours: **Madame Tussaud's:** Sunday – Thursday 10am to 8pm, Friday and Saturday 10am to 10pm. Memorial Day through Labor Day the museum is open until 10pm every day. **Ripley's Odditorium:** 9am to 1am every day.

NBC Studio Tour

- Location: W. 50th Street between 5th and 6th Avenue.
- The first stop on the tour is the NBC Sharp History Theatre, where you will learn about NBC's early days in radio. The globe-shaped theater is home to a 16 foot by 9 foot high-definition screen by Sharp and is equipped with surround sound. Your NBC Page will also tell you about some of the network's early sound effect techniques and NBC's transition into television.
- After learning about NBC's past, you will have the opportunity to enter and visit some of our most famous studios, including: The Today Show, Dateline NBC, NBC Nightly News, Late Night with Conan O'Brien, Football Night in America and Saturday Night Live.
- Tours are available Monday – Thursday 8:30am to 4:30pm (departing every 30 minutes); Friday – Saturday 9:30am to 5:30pm (departing every 15 minutes); Sunday 9:30am to 4:30pm (departing every 15 minutes).
- Tour length: 1 hour and 10 minutes
- Your tickets will be either mailed to you, your hotel or held for you at NBC Studios.

Dinner at The View Restaurant

- Location: Marriott Marquis Hotel (47th floor), Broadway between 45th and 46th Streets.
- The View is open for dinner Mon-Thu, 5:30pm-10pm; Fri, 5:30pm-11:30pm; Sat, 5pm-11:30pm; Sun, 5:30pm-10pm, 365 days a year. You may choose to dine any day, any time during your stay. *All arrangements will be made for you.* Together, we will decide the best time for you to have your meal at this must-visit New York restaurant.
- Your meal includes 3-courses, tax and gratuity. Drinks are paid for separately.

- You will be provided with a letter of pre-payment for you to present to the host/hostess upon your arrival. This will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The View is within an easy 5-minute walk to most Broadway theaters and within easy walking distance to most Midtown Manhattan hotels. Transportation to and/or from the restaurant is always available upon request for an additional charge.
- A full menu with more items to choose from is also available to you. If you decide to go with this menu then you will receive a credit towards your dinner and you will only have to pay the difference in the bill.

Special 2nd dinner

- Your restaurant will be specially selected by your concierge after you make your reservation and will reflect your choice of food, location and ambiance.
- Your dinner is pre-paid for \$75 per person. You will have access to the full restaurant menu, not a limited one, and will receive a bill only if you exceed the pre-paid amount.
- No vouchers are needed. You simply arrive at the restaurant, give them your name and you will be seated. The restaurant staff will be aware of your pre-payment.
- A day and time for your dinner will be selected by you and your concierge. You have plenty of freedom and flexibility in choosing when you will like to dine.
- Transportation to and from the restaurant can be arranged at your request for an extra charge.

Grayline New York 2-day double-decker bus tour

- Your vouchers will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- . All you need to do is exchange your vouchers for actual tickets at Grayline's convenient Midtown Manhattan ticket office and you're on your way.
- E-tickets give you the added value of security and peace of mind in case you lose your actual tickets. Since we will have additional copies of your tickets on file, we can just e-mail them to you or fax them to your hotel!
- Your tickets are good for 2 *consecutive days* of sightseeing. You may start your tour any day, any time you want during your stay.

- There is a licensed tour guide on board your double-decker bus at all time, pointing out sights and giving you interesting facts and stories about New York as you go along.

Empire State Building or Top of the Rock Observation Deck

- You may choose which observation deck you want to visit. You always have the option of adding in both observatories if you wish.

EMPIRE STATE BUILDING

- Location: 350 5th Avenue at 34th Street (Manhattan).
- The Empire State Building observation deck allows you to visit any day, any time during operating hours, giving you the freedom to decide while you're here when is the best time for you to go. The Observatory's regular hours of operation are: 8:00am to 2:00am 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Last elevators go up at 1:15am.
- The Empire State Building also has a newly re-opened 102nd Floor Observatory. Tickets are only sold upon arrival at the Empire State Building at a cost of \$15.00 in addition to regular admission tickets.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The Empire State Building's observatory is the tallest in the City (86th floor observatory is 1,050 feet; 320 meters), and is reached by high speed, automatic elevators, has both a glass-enclosed area, which is heated in winter and cooled in summer, and spacious outdoor promenades on all four sides of the Building. High powered binoculars are available on the promenades for the convenience of visitors at a minimal cost. Souvenir counters are also located in the 86th floor observatory. The 86th floor observatory is handicap accessible.
- ESB Express Pass: \$26 additional per person
The lines at the Empire State Building Observatory are as legendary as the building itself. The line actually consists of 3 different lines. The first one is the security line that everyone must go through. Next comes the ticket line. Visitors with pre-purchased tickets can skip this line which can save a considerable amount of time during our busiest times. The 3rd and last line is for the elevators that take you to the Observatory. By purchasing an Express Pass you will automatically be moved to the front of each and every line.

TOP OF THE ROCK

- Location: Entrance on 50th Street between 5th and 6th Avenues (Manhattan). Adjacent to Times Square.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The Top of the Rock observation deck is our personal favorite and has multi-media historical exhibits, an exciting elevator ride to the top and a unique view of the City.
- The Top of the Rock is open from 8am to midnight (last elevator up at 11pm), 365 days a year.
- Since the observation deck at Top of the Rock is on the 70th floor, you have the feeling of being suspended and floating in the middle of the Manhattan skyline. The view of the Empire State Building is picture perfect, as is the rest of the City from this awesome vantage point.
- Top of the Rock requires you to pick a date and time you would like to visit. This reduces the amount of time waiting in line.

Bicycle tour of Central Park

- You can take your tour at any of the following times: 10am, 1pm, and 4pm - 7 days a week and additional tours at 9am and 11am on summer weekends.
- All arrangements are made by your concierge. All you have to do is show up and enjoy the ride!

90-minute sightseeing boat cruise

- Location: New York Waterway – pier 78 at West 38th Street (on the Hudson River)
- Multiple departure times make it easy to fit this must-experience tour into your itinerary. Departure times vary according to the time of year but generally run at 10am, 11am, 12pm 1pm and 2pm all year round.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- The boat *does not* stop at the Statue of Liberty or Ellis Island but the tour does give you a breathtaking view of both of these famous landmarks. The sightseeing boat

cruise is a great way to see the Statue of Liberty up close without having to wait in long lines.

- All boats have an indoor and outdoor viewing area to accommodate all types of weather.
- Food and refreshments (including beer) are served on board.
- Getting to the pier to take your tour is simple, easy and inexpensive. A taxi from most Midtown Manhattan hotels typically costs no more than \$10 total (per taxi, not per person). *Free* shuttles are available to take you back to Midtown Manhattan.
- The Beast runs May through October and has multiple departure times throughout the day.
- Children must be at least 40" tall to ride The Beast.

Personal Concierge Service

- Your personal concierge is assigned to you the moment you make your reservation and is available to you throughout your stay in New York until the moment you're on your plane to go back home.
- Your concierge can really come in handy when it comes to planning all those things to do that are *outside* of your package. Things like finding the best places to go shopping, what's the best way to get around town, where are the best places to listen to some live music or where to find some great local restaurants.
- Our office hours are Monday through Friday 11am to 7pm and we are on call 24 hours a day as well as throughout the weekend if we are needed.

How It All Works:

Helicopter Tour

- Tours depart from the Downtown Manhattan Heliport, pier 6 and the East River.
- Tours are available throughout the day, Monday through Saturday. For Sunday tours, the Midtown Manhattan heliport is available for an additional \$15pp fee.
- Transportation to the heliport is not included but is certainly available to you upon request for an additional charge. Taxis are easily available and inexpensive.
- Your tickets will be mailed to you within 30 days of your arrival in New York, along with all of your other package details and tickets. If your arrival date is less than 40 days from when you make your reservation, then you will receive your tickets within 10 days of making your reservation.
- Tour description: an enhanced harbor tour that includes view's of New York City's five Boroughs! Luxury sedans (such as a Lincoln Town Car or Mercedes) are good for 2 people. SUVs are fun as an additional option and have large windows and are a little higher up off the ground so you can see a bit more.
- You can take your tour any day, any time you want. We recommend taking it the day after you arrive so you become more familiar with the City right away. Then you can spend the rest of your trip going back and spending more time at those places you enjoyed most during your tour.
- We will pick you up and drop you off at your hotel (or anywhere in Manhattan). Pick ups and drop offs are available at airports and areas outside of Manhattan for an additional charge.
